3. Charging station

Optionally there is a charging station available for the Kompy Pico. With this charging station it is even easier to charge the Kompy Pico. (The buttons on the charging base are non-functional)

- To use the charging station, you first connect the cable that is located on the bottom of the station to the provided power adapter.
- Plug in the adapter. A blue ring will now light up on the charging station.
- The charging station is now ready for use.
- To charge the Kompy Pico, simply place it into the charging station.

5. First use

Before the Kompy Pico can be used, you must carry out the following steps.

Opladen

To charge the Kompy Pico, connect the provided charging cable to the adapter and plug in the adapter. Connect the magnetic charging cable to the charging pins on the back of the Kompy Pico. The red LED will blink slowly during charging. It is recommended to charge the device for 4 hours before first use.

Activate

You can turn on the Kompy Pico by pressing the On/Off button for 3 seconds.

If you want to turn the device completely off, press and hold the on/off button and the SOS button for 3 seconds simultaneously.

6. Make an alarm

An alarm will be created by pressing and holding the alarm button for 3 seconds. There will be a beep sound and the green light of the Kompy Pico starts blinking.

When the alarm is activated, the alarm will be automatically forwarded in our platform to the appropriate caregivers or care center.

As long as an alarm has not been accepted and handled by the caregiver, the Kompy Pico remains the alarm. In this alarm phase, a new alarm call is not possible.


If the alarm is accepted by the caregiver, a voice connection can be made to start a conversation. If the caregiver calls to the Kompy Pico, a conversation will be established.

A conversation between the caregiver and you is only possible if you have pressed the alarm button. In all other cases, it is not possible to make a voice connection with the Kompy Pico.

To end the alarm, press the alarm button.
